SCHOLARSHIP FUND QUALIFICATIONS**

Applicants for the **Herman Jackson Scholarship** must:

- a. be a member of Friendship Baptist Church.
- b. **participate in one (1) Christian/youth activity per year (i.e. choir, usher board, youth activity, Sunday school, etc.) and contribute to the financial support of the church.**
- c. be a high school graduate or its equivalent with 2.5 grade point average or have at least a 2.5 grade point average at an accredited institution or vocational/trade school. Applicants must submit their most recent transcript.

NOTE:

- Grants are available to undergraduate and graduate students with preference being given to undergraduates.
- Undergraduate students may receive more than one grant over a four (4) year cumulative period. Graduate students are limited to one-time-only grant.
- All documents requested on application must be submitted with application.

Applicants for the **Mary Brown Scholarship Fund** must:

- a. be a high school graduate or its equivalent.
- b. may or may not be a member of Friendship Baptist Church.
- c. be enrolled or accepted at an accredited institution or vocational/trade school.

NOTE:

- Preference will be given to those who profess Christ.
- Grants will be available to undergraduate students only.
- Students are eligible to receive grants in multiple years.
- Students who receive Herman Jackson grants will not be eligible for Mary Brown grants during the same calendar year.
- All documents requested on application must be submitted with application.

Applicants for the **Henry L. Cotton, Jr. Scholarship Fund** must:

- a. be a high school graduate or its equivalent.
- b. may or may not be a member of the Friendship Baptist Church.
- c. be enrolled or accepted at an accredited college or vocational/trade school.

NOTE:

- Preference will be given to foster or adoptive students.
- Grants will be available to undergraduate students only.
- Students are eligible to receive grants in multiple years.
- The number and amount of grants given will be based on the funds available.
- Students who receive Herman Jackson or Mary Brown grants will not be eligible for Henry L. Cotton, Jr. grant during the same calendar year.
- All documents requested on application must be submitted with application.
