**SCHOLARSHIP FUND QUALIFICATIONS**

The Friendship Baptist Church has one Scholarship Fund-the **Herman L. Jackson, Sr., Scholarship Fund**. The Committee responsible for administering this fund shall consist of one member from Ministry of Christian Education, the Pastor, two members at large, two Deacons, and two Trustees. The Scholarship Committee shall be a part of and report to the Christian Education Ministry.

Members of the committee will be prohibited from voting on any application to whom they are related. **All monies donated to the church for scholarship, unless specifically noted, will go into the Herman Jackson Scholarship Fund.** The committee may, at their discretion, set limits on the amount of aid available to any one individual.

Recipients of this Fund currently must:

- a. Be a member of Friendship Baptist Church.
- b. Participate in one (1) Christian/youth activity per year (i.e., choir, usher board, youth activity, Sunday School, etc.) per year and contribute to the financial support of the church.
- c. Be a high school graduate or its equivalent with a 2.5 grade point average or have at least a 2.5 grade point average at an accredited institution or vocational/trade school. Applicants must submit their most recent transcript.

**NOTE:**

-Grants are available to undergraduate and graduate students-with preference being given to undergraduates.

-Undergraduate students may receive more than one grant over a four (4) cumulative period. Graduate students are limited to one-time-only grant.

There shall be a sub-fund under the Herman Jackson Scholarship Fund known as the Mary Brown Scholarship Fund. To be eligible for the Mary Brown Scholarship fund, a person:

- a. must be a high school graduate or its equivalent.
- b. may or may not be a member of Friendship Baptist Church.
- c. must be enrolled or accepted at an accredited institution or vocational/trade school.

**NOTE:**

- Preference will be given to those who profess Christ.
- Grants will be available to undergraduate students only.
- Students are eligible to receive grants in multiple years.
- Students who receive Herman Jackson grants will no be eligible for Mary Brown grants during the same calendar year.
- Money donated to the Mary Brown Scholarship fund must be specifically designated for that fund at the time it is given.**

There shall be a sub-fund under the Herman Jackson Scholarship fund known as the Henry L. Cotton, Jr., Scholarship Fund. To be eligible for the Henry L. Cotton, Jr. Scholarship fund, a person:

- a. must be a high school graduate or its equivalent.
- b. May or may not be a member of the Friendship Baptist Church.
- c. Must be enrolled or accepted at an accredited college or vocational/trade school.

**NOTE:**

- Preference will be given to foster or adoptive students.
- Grants will be available to undergraduate students only.
- Students are eligible to receive grants in multiple years.
- The number and amount of grants given will be based on the funds available.
- Students who receive Herman Jackson or Mary Brown grants will not be eligible for Henry L. Cotton, Jr. grant during the same calendar year.
- Money donated to the Henry L. Cotton, Jr., Scholarship Fund must be specifically designated for that fund at the time it is given.**

**Awards will be made payable to student and institution they are attending or will attend.**
